Approval of Minutes from the August 6th, 2013 Joint & Village Board meetings

Public Hearing- Increasing the Sanitation fees by 12%, the Water rates by 8.73% and the Sewer rates by 7.74%

Trustee Rue explained that the increases in the water, sewer & sanitation fees are due to the upcoming projects in the various departments.

Adoption of Fee Increases

Discussion: Recycling in the Village of Monticello

Mayor Jenkins announced that the Village is going to start a recycling program in the Village and plans to set up fines and fees for violators. This is being done to try to balance out the tipping fees that the Village is paying because of the lack of recycling. The Village is going to be aggressive and plans to enforce these fines and once they are established they will be located in the Fee Schedule.

Mayor/Manager Report

Mayor Jenkins stated that he has spoken with the Village Attorney and he is sending a letter to the US Department of Justice in regards to the actions taken by Trustee Rue against several Village employees. He stated that something has to be done and that the employees should not have to put up with or be subject to Trustee Rue and her continued false statements & accusations that she puts on her website and in the local newspapers. Per Mayor Jenkins, everyone that works in the Village does a great job and is dedicated and does not deserve Trustee Rue's abuse.
