MOTION TO ACCEPT THE AGENDA

A motion was made by Trustee Bennett, seconded by Trustee Rue, unanimously approved on a roll call to accept the Agenda for the Village of Monticello Meeting on March 31, 2015.

DISCUSSION OF THE WATER DELIVERY SYSTEM INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMNTS

Anthony Eagan the engineer of Barton and Loguidice discussed the details that would be involved with this project. Mr. Eagan discussed the savings on Interest rates stating that the interest rate was originally stated to be 3% and they got it scaled back to 2 1/8 %. Mr. Eagan went on to say that the USDA has offered to issue grants in the amount of 1.25 million which affords a larger project if need be.

Mr. Eagan discussed that replacement and or rehab on Pump Stations, Valves, Hydrants as well as replacing tanks on the Hospital Hills. Mr. Eagan said that one mile of Watermain will be looped around Carpenter Street, Hill Crest Avenue, Myrtle Avenue, Osborne Street, Plesantview, Roosa Avenue and Thorton Avenue to help the water problems on these locations. Mr. Eagan stated that any leftover monies from the USDA funds can be used to do more work if need be, with that being said Mr. Eagan stated that with the purchasing of the Meters, installing the meters, Engineering Service, Planning Design, Bidding, Construction, Phase Operations and Close Outs that the amount to be paid comes out to be \$998,000. According to Mr. Eagan the original Form E presented in February was 1 million 52 thousand and their proposal is well below that price. A question was asked about the time period to pay back the loan if the Village gets one, Mr. Eagan said it would be a 38 year loan. Mayor Jenkins stated that the businesses and developers that annexed into the Village are some of the reasons for these extra services and problems that come from annexations, he feels that they should be charged to help pay for these services that will improve the Village and help on payments they will occur with this project.
